

Her adventures in New York, Jamaica, Africa, and Europe highlight two deep-rooted beliefs – the importance of knowing one's history and that true learning is often achieved through a connection to the larger world.

From the hallways of 409 Edgecombe venue in Harlem, her childhood home where her neighbors included future Supreme Court Justice Thurgood Marshall and social scientist and civil rights activist W.E.B. Du Bois, to the halls of academia and the front lines of the civil rights movement, Butler Jones' life is a timeless journey of curiosity, discovery and enlightenment.
